EPS Growth Rate is the projected growth rate in earnings per share for the next five years. Return on Equity is the average amount of net income returned as a percentage of shareholder's equity over the past five years. Asset Weighted Market Cap is the value of a corporation as determined by the number of outstanding shares of common stock multiplied by the price per share.

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
