

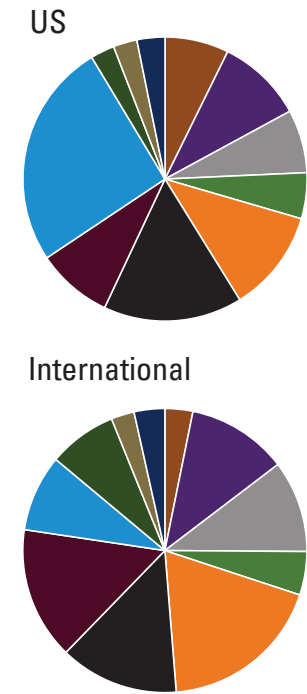
Looking Abroad Can Help Broaden Your Sector Diversification

US and international equities provide access to the same sectors, but with varied exposures to each. The US is more tech heavy, for example. International investing may help you to benefit from strong growth outside the US while balancing unintended sector bias.
