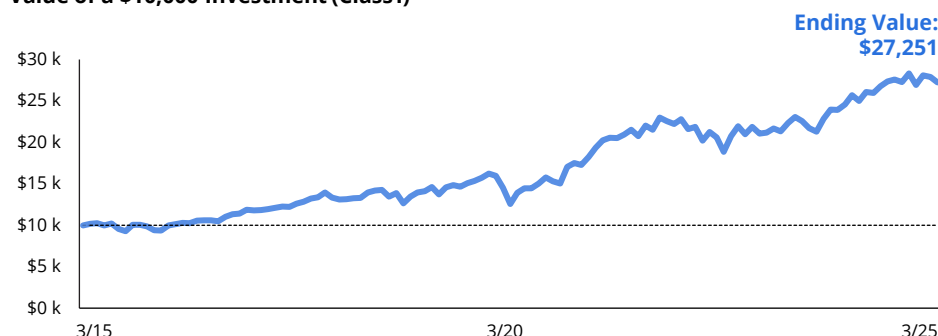

Turnover shown excludes To-Be-Announced roll transactions, if any. **Price/Earnings** is the ratio of a stock's price to its earnings per share. **Price/Book** is the ratio of a stock's price to its book value per share. **EPS Growth Rate** is the projected growth rate in earnings per share for the next five years. **Return on Equity** is the average amount of net income returned as a percentage of shareholder's equity over the past five years. **Asset Weighted Market Cap** is the value of a corporation as determined by the number of outstanding shares of common stock multiplied by the price per share.
