

## IMPORTANT YEAR-END TAX INFORMATION

The following information should be used in conjunction with your 2020 tax return as the owner of a **Coverdell Education Savings Account (ESA)**.

- As noted in the instructions on **Form 1099-Q**, Hartford Funds is not required to include earnings (other than earnings on excess contributions) and basis in **Boxes 2 and 3**. This information must still be reported when filing your taxes.
- To figure your earnings and basis, use the Coverdell ESA-Taxable Distributions and Basis Worksheet in IRS Publication 970, which can be found at [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov) or by calling the IRS at (800) 829-1040. The total value of your account is the value reflected on your 12/31/2020 statement, and may also be shown on your 1099-Q as fair market value (FMV) located next to box 6.
